Lance Corporal 2nd Bn South Wales Borderers - *Enlisted Brecon*

Died Saturday 1st July 1916 - *Killed in action*

15th October 1915 - Wounded at the Front: News has been received by the parents of Private F Boon RFA and Private T Boon SLI of their being wounded in the fighting in the Dardanelles.

Brothers missing and Wounded. News has been received from the War Office by Mr George Boon of West Street that his son Corporal Frank Boon of the South Wales Borderers, has been missing since July 1st, the first day of the great advance; also that his eldest son, Signaller Charles Boon of the same regiment has been wounded in the recent heavy fighting in France. Private Thomas Boon of the Somerset Light Infantry, another son who is now discharged, was wounded earlier in the war.
