

**Albert Bowden**

On Stoke Roll of Honour

21st May 1915 - Private Albert Bowden (1st Dorsets) killed on Hill 60.

3/8455 Pte A Bowden (b Yeovil; e Glamorgan) died of wounds on 27th April 1915 when serving with the 1st Dorsets. He is buried in Boulogne East Cemetery in France. It is not known when he sustained the injuries from which he died but it is likely that it was in the part of the battle for Hill 60 known as the Battle of Gravenstafel Ridge which took place 22 - 23rd April 1915.
