9 November 1917 - Mr & Mrs J Denman of Castle St have received news that their son Lance Corporal George Denman SLI has been awarded the MM for conspicuous gallantry in face of the enemy.

14 December 1917 - Lance Corporal Denman's MM. the parents of Lance Corporal George Denman SLI have received the following official account as to how he won the MM:

"In the attack on 4.10.17 near, this man showed great devotion to duty. The remainder of his Lewis gun team became casualties, but he still worked his gun. He went into the open to collect magazines and spare parts so that he could keep his gun in action.

19 April 1918 - Mrs J Denman, Castle St, has received a letter regarding the death of her son Corporal G Denman MM recently killed in action. The letter states:

Your son was killed by a shell on 27th March 1918, and his death was instantaneous. He was a very brave and excellent corporal, well beloved by everyone in the battalion. His death is a great loss to the company."
