1916.

December.FRONT LINE.

13th. 10 p.m. Battn. in line weather very bad. Men stuck in mud and in many cases had to be dug out without their boots. Four German prisoners taken 119th Grenadiers (Courtenburgers).

GUILLEMONT.

14th. Battn. in line heavily shelled by enemy at time of relief 5 Casualties O.R. an two officers wounded. Major Wardlaw and 2nd Lt. Betterley. relieved by 7 K.O.Y.L.I. and marched to GUILLEMONT.

CAMP XVII CARNOY.

15th. 10 pm. Marched from GUILLEMONT to Camp XVII CARNOY.

16th. 10 pm. Battn. cleaning up and resting 32 cases trench feet reported.

17th. 10 pm. Battn. cleaning up. 120 men called for, for working parties.

FRONT LINE.

18th. 10 pm. Relieved 10th K.R.R.C. in front line marching in from Camp XVII.

19th. 10 pm. Battn. in front line heavy frost, enemy line heavily bombarded.

GUILLEMONT.

20th. 10 pm. Relieved in front line by 7 K.O.Y.L.I. Marched to GUILLEMONT. 3 Casualties.

CAMP XVII.

21st. 10 pm. Marched to Camp XVII.

BEAULTE.

22nd. 10 pm. Battn. marched to rest billets at BEAULTE.

23rd. 10 pm. Battn. in rest billets at BEAULTE. Coys under Coy. Commanders.

24th. 10 pm. Battn. in rest billets at BEAULTE, Church parade, and cleaning up.
