

7th BATTALION SOMERSET LIGHT INFANTRY.Appendix.1917.February.COISY.

- 1st 10 p.m. Battalion in billets. Attack on Trenches with live Grenades. Premature explosion of grenade, causing six casualties, including C.O. & 2nd i/c.
- 2nd 10 p.m. Battalion in billets. Practice Attack on Strong Points, using live Grenades.
- 3rd 10 p.m. Battalion in billets. Practice attack on Trenches. Capt. C.R.D. Cleminson, D.S.O. (12th Kings') took over Temp. Command of Batt.
- 4th 10 p.m. Battalion in billets. Practice attack on a Strong Point.
- 5th 10 p.m. Battalion in billets. Reorganisation & refitting of Coys.

CARNOY.

- 6th 10 p.m. Battalion moved from COISY to CARNOY by motor bus, leaving COISY at 10 a.m.

GUILLEMONT.

- 7th 10 p.m. Battalion marched from CARNOY to GUILLEMONT.

IN LINE.

- 8th 10 p.m. Battalion relieved 2nd Hampshire Regt. 3 wounded.
- 9th 10 p.m. Evacuated front line of Trenches at dawn, in view of bombardment of BOSNIA trench, reoccupied front line after dark bombardment ceased. Casualties 1 killed. 4 wounded.
- 10th 10 p.m. Evacuated front line at dawn, bombardment was carried out on BOSNIA Trench, reoccupied front line after dark bombardment ceased. Battalion was relieved by the 7th D.C.L.I. and returned to CARNOY. Casualties 3 killed and 20 wounded.

CARNOY.

- 11th 10 p.m. Battalion in CARNOY Camp 6.
- 12th 10 p.m. Battalion in CARNOY Camp 6.

GUILLEMONT.

- 13th 10 p.m. Battalion moved to from CARNOY to GUILLEMONT.
