3.58 pm	Aug 21 st Aug
CHOCOLATE HILL	<p>Received message from 4th Coy to say that all officers had been either killed or wounded + the majority of men. Whole attack disorganized + split up by fires which were spreading in every direction, burning many of our wounded alive.</p>
4.20 pm	"
"	<p>Lance Fusibis ordered to reinforce survivors of the Bde + take them on to Hill 112. Received message Hill 70 captured on our left flank by</p>
5 PM.	"
"	<p>Lance Fusibis unable to advance owing to heavy ^(R. Infiltrating Force) machine gun fire. message received from Captain Wilson that he had a few survivors with him, but that the men were all split up into little groups taking cover where they could from the fire + the burning gorse.</p>
5.15 PM.	"
"	<p>After repeated message to the Bde stating that 11th Division which was supposed to be supporting us on the right, had not appeared, were informed that they were doing magnificently + had stated that they were in possession of Hill 112.</p>
6.5 pm.	"
"	<p>Some units of the 11th Division suddenly appeared over the crest line of CHOCOLATE HILL behind us, + had to be told not to open fire on our backs.</p>
6.20 pm.	"
"	<p>Message received from anty.co. that he + 20 men + succeeded in getting back to our front line + were in the trenches held by the</p>
