Hour, Date, Place.	Summary of Events and Information.	Remarks and
6.50 pm Aug 21 <sup>st</sup> CHOCOLATE HILL	Dublin Fusiliers. Message received from Capt. Murray that he had about 40 men with him in a trench 50 yards in front of firing line. They were ordered back to our Hqs. by the Bde.	
8 PM. "	Survivors of the Bde, numbers 140 formed up in hollows behind Hill 53. Bde strength before the action 717. Throughout the night, men continued to come in & by the morning there were nearly 300. Nine officers were casualties.	
Aug 22 <sup>nd</sup> "	Orders received that the Dublin Fusiliers & Royal Fusiliers were to hold the firing line - while the Lancashire Fusiliers & ourselves remained in reserve. Remained in same position all day.	
6 PM. "	Bde began to move out of its position in the hollow & reassembled at <del>the</del> CHOCOLATE Hill.	
8.30 pm. "	Bde joined remainder of Bde & moved off to trenches 2 miles north of CHOCOLATE Hill, arriving 11.30 PM.	
1 am. Aug 23 <sup>rd</sup>	Bde remained in hollow by Bde Hqs. during the night.	
6 am. "	Bde moved to another hollow 300 yards in front of Bde Hqs. & bivouacked there. Royal Fusiliers & Dublin Fusiliers in firing line.
