Owing to the heavy firing last night, our Patriots were unable to approach as close as usual to the enemy line but they were able to note that no enemy movement occurred in his front line - The Stokes mortars fired three times during the night on our front, March 31 - being the end of the fiscal year, the Paymaster, under orders turned in all vouchers and cash balance to Field Cashier. His returns were shown in his cash book & after verification, marked "Correct" by the Field Cashier -</p>	RAO'S

Our artillery was quite active at intervals during the preceding night - From 9.30 pm until 11 pm our 15 pounders shelled the enemy's line about S.15.C.3.6 and S.15.C.4.7. (approximately). From 10 am till 12 noon today our heavies fired about 60 rounds on the enemy's back area - From 2.45 pm until 4 o'clock pm our guns were very active in retaliation.</p>
